



WEST LOTHIAN GOLF CLUB CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PARENTS/CAREGIVERS OF JUNIOR AND JUVENILE MEMBERS

As a parent/caregiver of a junior and/or juvenile member of West Lothian Golf Club you are expected to abide by the following code of conduct.

You should:

- Ensure your child knows and understands the code of conduct that applies to them;
- Encourage/support the behaviours outlined and expected in the codes;
- Encourage your child to learn the rules and play within them;
- Encourage your child to respect the golf course, clubhouse and their own equipment;
- Discourage unfair play and arguing with club staff/officials;
- Help your child to recognise good performance, not just results;
- Never force your child to take part in golf;
- Set a good example by recognising fair play and applauding good performances of all;
- Never punish or belittle your child for losing or making mistakes;
- Publicly accept any officials' judgements;
- Support your child's involvement and help them to enjoy their sport;
- Use correct and proper language at all times;
- Never use threatening or abusive behaviour towards children, officials, coaches or other parents; and
- Communicate respectfully and effectively with the Junior Convenor, volunteers and Caimin's Team.
